## What Does School Council Do?

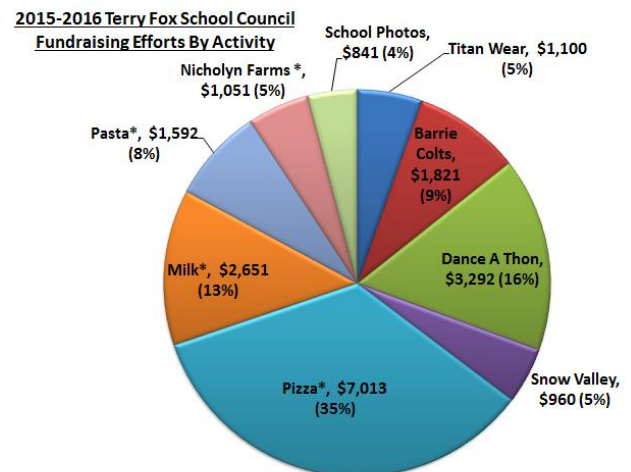
A significant portion of School Council's work is devoted to providing and supporting services that benefit our students and school community. Some examples are:

- Eat Well to Excel which provides food in the office for those who are hungry
- Milk program which provides a consistent healthy lunch option (cost to parents)
- Titan Wear for students to show their school spirit (cost to parents)
- ECO schools and playground enhancements
- Special food days (e.g. pizza) (cost to parents)
- New ideas are always welcome!

School Council runs several fundraising campaigns to support initiatives in our school. Profits from fundraisers are allocated to:

- Extra-Curricular Activities (20%) – New outside balls and team uniforms.
- School Yard Enhancements (10%) – Regular updates to our playground.
- Classroom Technology (30%) - Every class now has an iPad
- Library (13%) - New books and resources
- Agendas (10%) - Every student gets their own in September.
- General School Needs (10%)
- Graduation Ceremony (7%)
